MOA anticipates that the project will be constructed in summer 2021.

The E. 6th Avenue improvements will consist of the installation of two permanent radar speed signs, two speed humps, and a raised crosswalk at the intersection of E. 6th Avenue and North Valley Road.

The Cherry Street improvements will consist of the installation of two speed cushions, widening the sidewalks for Muldoon Elementary students, and roadway narrowing. The project will include paving, driveway reconstruction, new curb and gutter, curb ramps, and minor drainage improvements.
